



1. 1st Online Global Cancer Conference 'From Crux to Consensus'

The Breast Global platform recently successfully concluded its 1st Online Global Breast Cancer Conference between 25-27th June 2021, centered around the theme, "From Crux to Consensus". Well-established and internationally acclaimed Breast Cancer societies like the European Society of Surgical Oncology, Senologic International Society, European Society of Breast Cancer Specialists, Breast Surgery International, Senaturk, EUBREAST, European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS) teamed up with Breast Global to deliver the conference. The conference had three action-packed days, where international experts delivered lectures, conducted surgical video sessions, showcased new surgical techniques, participated in lively debates as well as live online polls. The virtual meeting broke geographical barriers and encouraged a large proportion of health care workers globally to join and participate actively. The conference was very well received by the global community and had 2250 registrations, with tremendous and applaudable feedback from the international faculty as well as the delegates. The conference faculty roster included global luminaries such as Dr. Gail Lebovic (President, SOS, USA), Prof. Isabel Rubio (President ESSO, Spain). Prof. Jerome Pereira (Program Director, Surgery UEA, UK). Prof. Mauricio Magalhaes Costa, (President SIS, Brazil), Prof. Richard Rainsbury (Hampshire Hospitals NHS Trust, UK) to just name a few. Dr. Ben Anderson, in charge of delivering the WHO Breast Global Health Initiative also participated in this congress and shared salient features of the programme which was aligned with those of the platform. Lifetime achievement awards were presented to two giants who revolutionized oncoplastic breast surgery on either side of the Atlantic, Prof. Melvin Silverstein, USA, and Prof. Maurizio Bruno Nava, Italy.



This study aims to cover the medical and family history of the patient and the biological interpretation of the mutation detected thus highlighting the importance of genetic testing.




