#### 2) International Conference in Delhi



### PRASHANTI HOSTS A WORKSHOP ON EARLY AND ADVANCED BREAST CANCER: 4<sup>th</sup> AND 5<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2017



The 1<sup>st</sup> practical training workshop of the Masters in Breast Oncoplasty Program (UK) will be conducted on the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> of November. This training program jointly organised by University of East Anglia (UK) and Prashanti Cancer Care Mission. The training will be imparted in the form of intensive surgical workshops with one on one interactions between mentors and peers. Various methods of practical training such as live mark-up models, surgical simulations on synthetic breast models, virtual video sessions and case-based discussion will be employed for relevant learning. Eminent faculty from UK, Dr. John Benson and Dr. Jen Smith will be conducting these sessions along with renowned faculty from all across India. This will serve as a platform to network with key opinion leaders and like-minded peers from across the world. The current cohort have students enrolled from India, Sri Lanka and Indonesia.
